Echeverria Sauvignon Blanc, Curico Valley, Chile <i>Bright, lively and fresh with a long and lasting aroma of ripe green melons and grass.</i>	£16.50
Pinot Grigio IGT Venezia, Cielo e Terra, Italy <i>A dry white wine with a mineral character and a round and spicy flavour.</i>	£17.00
Oveja Negra Sauvignon Carmenere, Chile <i>Highly aromatic and fresh with scents of passionfruit and citrus notes of grapefruit and lime, accompanied by intense mineral notes. Medium bodied on the palate with crisp acidity and a long finish.</i>	£17.50
Château Nicot, AC Entre Deux Mers, France <i>On the nose, this wine is highly aromatic with the delicious characteristic fragrances of Sauvignon and Sémillon grapes. It is quite rich in style, but with clean and fresh fruit flavours.</i>	£18.50
Gavi di Gavi "Fossili" San Silvestro, Piemonte, Italy <i>Spicy with a pleasant mineral tone and a crisp finish. Good with spicy food.</i>	£19.50
Andeluna Chardonnay, Argentina <i>Light straw-yellow colour, aromas of pineapple and tropical fruits on the nose. Crisp acidity on the palate, well rounded with fresh tropical fruits and a rich, long finish.</i>	£20.00
Tuatara Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand <i>A well rounded and fresh wine with a delicate aroma of sweet honeysuckle, tropical fruits and a hint of herbs.</i>	£21.00

Foundstone Shiraz, Berton Vineyards, Australia

£15.00

With lifted aromas of plums and coffee vanillin oak signalling the intensely concentrated ripe plum, black cherry and spicy white pepper on the palate. The flavours combine with the sweet toasty oak and soft tannins to create a beautiful layering of taste and texture that continues to a long lingering finish.

Echeverria Merlot, Curico Valley, Chile

Showing plummy fruit with good depth and texture, slightly herbaceous.

Oveja Negra Cabernet Franc Carmenere, Chile

£17.00

Attractive nose with aromas of raspberry and cherry with a touch of plum and spicy notes. Juicy and well balanced with a medium intensity and a soft touch of oak, tobacco and coffee on the palate.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Feudi d'Albe, Vinicola Bove, Italy

£18.00

Full-flavoured, pleasantly dry with a hint of liquorice and a bouquet reminiscent of wild berries.

Beaujolais Villages Château de Souzy, France

£18.50

Ruby red with a red berry aroma. Medium body, crisp acidity with an abundance of blackcurrant and raspberry on the palate. Soft and rounded on the finish.

Valpolicella Classico Superiore, Italy

£19.00

A dry, well structured and velvety red wine with a fragrant bouquet and a hint of bitter almonds in the background.

Rioja Crianza "Rivallana" Ondarre, Spain

£20.00

Powerful fruit aromas well-combined with hints of oak ageing. On the palate it reveals concentrated, ripe fruit flavours and good structure.

Château Bégadan Cru Artisan, AC Médoc, France

£22.50

This wine shows aromas of ripe figs, spice and toasty oak with a round and silky palate feel. An elegantly structured wine with good length on the finish.

Pennys Hill Shiraz Cabernet, McLaren Vale, Australia

£24.50

A well balanced wine, full of dark berry fruits with hints of tobacco and chocolate. The wine shows spice, sweet fruit with the dark, briary Shiraz fruit. Smooth and complex with soft tannins.

Saint Clair Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand

£26.50

A medium-bodied easy drinking Pinot Noir with a soft, full palate well balanced acidity and flavours that linger. Black cherry dominates the palate and is supported with hints of plum and red currant along with spicy oak.

This wine is clean and fruity with lively bubbles and is ideal served as an aperitif.

Moutard Grande Cuvée Champagne

Fine, rich, developed nose with fragrances of butter, almond and brioche.
